What is it?

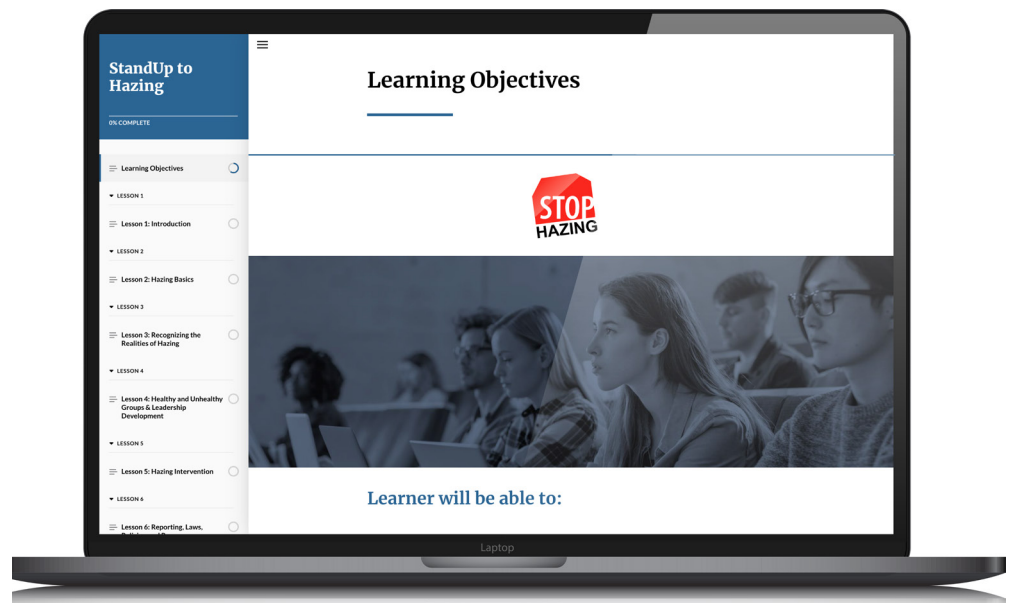
- A 20-minute, self-guided, online course developed by StopHazing and other experts in hazing prevention
